Subject: DNR Fire Mobilization
Date: September 21, 2010

The fall fire season has come early and outlooks indicate that we are most likely heading for increasing fire danger. DNR Fire does have resources available to assist you with fireline operations. DNR Fire staffs Type 6 and Type 7 engines from Fire Headquarters in northern Monroe County. Additionally, we have other off-road equipment and vehicles that can be mobilized. With the elevated fire danger, we are staffing adjusted hours dependent upon fire danger. Nonetheless, we have personnel on-call 24/7 throughout the fire season.

DNR Fire can provide an array of assistance, however typically our resources are utilized for line construction, hazard tree felling and technical assistance.
